2. Name any two types of food and any two types of drink mentioned in this sura. Give the verse number(s).

In which ayat of this sura does Allah (swt) talk about the bees making honey and what two things does he tell us about honey?

3. In which ayat of this sura does Allah (swt) talk about food which is Haraam for us? Which types of food have been mentioned in this ayat?

Why do you think it is important to be aware of the food which we put into our bodies?

4. In ayats #5-7 of this sura, Allah (swt) mentions that He has created the cattle, and in them are many advantages. List any three advantages of cattle as stated in this ayat.

5. According to this sura, why are birds a sign for those who believe? Give the ayat number.

Try this activity from <u>https://askabiologist.asu.edu/</u> to better understand how Allah (swt) created birds to fly. *Take a piece of paper. The best type of papers to use are the thin sheets used in magazines. Hold the short edge of the paper up [near] to your mouth using both hands. Blow hard across the top of the paper.*
